



## HUDSON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC CODE OF CONDUCT

- Student athletes must follow FHSAA guidelines for eligibility.
- All student athletes are expected to demonstrate positive sportsmanship during all competitions.
- All student athletes must follow both Hudson High School student guidelines and Pasco County Schools Student Code of Conduct.
- Out of School Suspension (OSS) on a game day renders the student athlete **ineligible** to play.
- Athletes must be in **attendance ALL DAY** in order to play (appointments must be communicated to coach or athletic director in advance when possible).
- Failure to attend practice the day before a game renders athlete ineligible for that game.
- Missing three practices **without notification** will result in dismissal from team.
- Student athletes who participate in inappropriate activities as seen on social media or during the school day will face suspension and/or dismissal from team. Principal, Athletic Director, and coach will determine consequence(s).
- Student athletes who are ejected from a competition will be responsible for any fines from FHSAA and will sit the number of games as determined by FHSAA. Hudson High School will not be responsible for fines.
- Athletes who quit or who are dismissed from a team will not be allowed to practice with or participate in another sport until the first sport's season has concluded.

### LOSS OF PRIVILEGES

STUDENT ATHLETES MAY BE SUBJECT TO LOSS OF PRIVILEGES FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Failing grades in classes
- Excessive tardies and/or absences
- Behavior issues

*\*Decision to "bench" a student athlete as disciplinary action for loss of privilege will be at the discretion of coach and school administration.*
