



WCD Policy

Students who bring WCDs to school must ensure that they remain on silent mode and completely out of view for the entire school day except for the student's lunch period, or as expressly authorized by the classroom teacher for a specific instructional activity. Classroom teachers may also provide, and students may utilize, a cell phone storage area in their classroom. These expectations also apply to extra-curricular and co-curricular activities that occur before or after the school day. All students will be asked to place cell phones/WCD in a storage area OR the device must always be in student's bookbag/backpack. This includes Apple Watches or any messaging device. Teachers will provide a safe storage area for cellphones in each classroom and provide procedures in the syllabus regarding parent notification.

Interventions

- 1** Verbal Warning
- 2** Parent notification and WCD held until dismissal by staff member
- 3** Parent notification and WCD held until dismissal in front office. Referral written. Device remains at home or checked into front office for specified amount of time determined by school administrator.
- 4** Parent notification and WCD held until dismissal in front office. **Referral written.** Parent conference with school administrator. WCD must remain at home or checked in daily to front office for remainder of semester or specified period.
- 5** Parent notification and WCD held until dismissal in front office. Referral written. Parent conference with school administrator will occur, behavior agreement will be put in place with guidelines related to WCD check in plan. WCD must remain at home with no option to bring any WCD on campus for a specified period (may result in loss of privilege through end of semester or school year).

*Students refusing to comply with any intervention may receive OSS (out of school suspension).
